»The previous UV system on this press was an ageing water-cooled system that took up a lot of space for the chiller and required continuous maintenance to repair leaks and burst pipes«, said Phil BARTLETT, Production Supervisor at *Baker*. »Parts were becoming obsolete and the UV lamps tended to overheat causing downtime on the press.«

The VCP system has fully aircooled lamp heads capable of curing a wide range of heat-sensitive substrates without the need for a chiller system making it compact and easy to maintain.
